### **CN – Yale Young Global Scholars for Outstanding High School Students**

Yale sponsors seven intensive interdisciplinary summer pre-collegiate experiences – Sustainable Development and Social Entrepreneurship; Politics, Law, and Economics; International Affairs and Security; Applied Science and Engineering; Biological and Biomedical Science; Frontiers of Science and Technology; Asia in the 21st Century. Students learn from leading authorities in their areas of expertise; read primary source materials, articles, and books on a wide variety of issues; participate in lively team exercises and simulations; and gain invaluable instruction in university-level writing. Admission is selective.
