

The Kleinert Family Scholarship Application

This \$1,000 scholarship is established by Sharon Kleinert, in memory of her mother, Martha J. McGavic Stamper, to honor her life and legacy especially her commitment and belief in the importance of education and empowering women to create a better society.

The purpose of this scholarship is to enable a student living in Southern Indiana the opportunity to attend Assumption High School.

Criteria:

The Kleinert Scholarship is awarded to a rising Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, or Senior attending Assumption High School, who meets the following criteria:

1. Lives in Southern Indiana
2. Demonstrates a commitment to Christian leadership through service opportunities
3. Applies herself in the classroom to the best of her abilities and values academic success
4. Expresses a positive outlook on life and encourages others
5. Demonstrates passion and purpose in her service to others
6. Preference is given to students who demonstrate need and apply for aid based upon the School's formal financial aid application process.
7. Applicants should be positive role models both in and outside of school; good representatives of AHS values; and be in good academic and disciplinary standing and not have any significant attendance issues.

Submissions for this scholarship should be in the form of a one-page (double-spaced) typed essay along with two letters of recommendation (one from a teacher and one from the community at large) must be completed. In the essay the student should explain how she works to her fullest potential and meets the criteria stated above and a cover page should accompany the essay and include the applicant's name and the name of the scholarship.
