# MATH AND LANGUAGE PLACEMENT TEST INFORMATION FOR THE CLASS OF 2025

### ARCHDIOCESAN ALGEBRA I PROGRAM

Catholic grade school students who participated in the Archdiocesan Algebra I Program will take their exit exam at their school. They **do not** need to test at Assumption. Details about time may be obtained from the Archdiocesan grade schools.

#### **ALGEBRA I**

Students who attend **public or non-Catholic private schools** and will complete the equivalent to high school Algebra I curriculum at their grade schools and wish to begin their high school math study in Geometry <u>or</u> who would like to be tested for a more advanced level Algebra I placement need to come to Assumption High School on **Wednesday**, **May 26 at 3:30 p.m.** to take their placement test. Students need to bring No. 2 pencils and are not permitted to use calculators. The test will take place in Room 204 which is easily accessed from the main entrance at the Tyler Lane side of the building. The test will take approximately one hour.

## **WORLD LANGUAGE (French or Spanish)**

Students who would like to be tested in French or Spanish for a more advanced level placement in their first year of a language <u>or</u> who would like to begin French II or Spanish II need to come to Assumption High School on **Wednesday, May 26 at 3:30 p.m.** Students should have had daily intensive world language instruction to take this test. Students need to bring writing instruments. The test will take place in Room 202, which is easily accessed from the main entrance at the Tyler Lane side of the building. The test will take approximately one hour.

### BOTH ALGEBRA AND WORLD LANGUAGE

Students who would like to take both the algebra and the language placement tests may take both on this day. We ask that they test for Geometry first in room 204 then report to room 202 to start the language placement.
