

The Crum Family Scholarship

This scholarship was established by graduate, Jennifer Crum Balmos '98, in honor of her parents, Jim and Terry Crum. It will benefit a student of Assumption High School with a history of serving others or with a demonstrated desire to do so in her career. This may be demonstrated through participation in service activities inside and/or outside of Assumption or enrollment and achievement in classes related to her chosen career (teaching, law, medicine, ministry, etc.) or participation in a student government activity at Assumption such as Student Council, Class Officers, or Family Rep. The applicant should be known for her positive school spirit, academic achievement, and she must qualify for financial assistance. This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a **current** freshman, sophomore, or junior who meets the following criteria and it will be applied to their tuition for the following school year:

- Students(s) must demonstrate need and apply for aid based upon the School's formal financial aid application process.
- Maintain B average or above
- Demonstrated leadership by performing community service or through participation in a student government activity at Assumption.
- Applicants should be positive role models both in and outside of school; good representatives of AHS values; and be in good academic and disciplinary standing and not have any significant attendance issues.

An essay with at least three paragraphs should be completed. The essay should explain why the student feels she fits the criteria for the scholarship, how she demonstrates service and leadership and what the scholarship means to her as a possible recipient.
