

Maria and Thomas Devasia Scholarship

This scholarship was established by Rose Devasia Anderson '90, to honor her parents Maria and Thomas Devasia who worked hard to provide a Catholic education for their children.

The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize an Assumption student who: personifies empathy by showing exemplary Christian leadership; and perseverance through academics and service in her school and community. In addition, to promote racial and ethnic diversity at Assumption High School, this scholarship will be awarded to a student who is a member of a racial or ethnic minority.

Criteria:

This scholarship will be awarded to an incoming 8th grader, a current Freshman, Sophomore, or Junior who meets the following criteria:

1. Students(s) must demonstrate need and apply for aid based upon the School's formal financial aid application process.
2. Maintain B average or above
3. Represents racial or ethnic diversity by being a member of a racial or ethnic minority
4. Must be involved in school-related activities
5. Must demonstrate academic achievement
6. Must be involved in community service
7. Applicants should be positive role models both in and outside of school; good representatives of AHS values; and be in good academic and disciplinary standing and not have any significant attendance issues.

Application Process:

A letter of recommendation from the community at large, and a typed, one-page essay must be completed.
