This fund hopes to award one or more non-renewable scholarship(s) of up to \$1000 annually to a student(s) who meets the following criteria:

- Award(s) will be given to a rising Sophomore, Junior, and/or Senior at Assumption High School.
- Award(s) will go to student(s) with demonstrated need based upon the
  School's formal financial aid application process.
- Student(s) must have a B average or above at the time of application.
- Student must complete interview with an immigrant or someone whose family member immigrated from another country to the United States.
- Student(s) must continue in foreign language studies during their time at AHS.
- Applicants should be positive role models both in and outside of school; good representatives of AHS values; a and be in good academic and disciplinary standing and not have any significant attendance issues.

Submissions for this scholarship should be in the form of a typed essay which refers to the criteria above. The essay should be two double-spaced pages.
