

## The LaFollette Family Scholarship

This scholarship was created in memory of Charles “Terry” LaFollette, husband of Mary Ann Steltenpohl LaFollette '69, to honor his life and legacy. His life reflected his faith and his love for his family. This scholarship will allow his legacy to live on through the ability to help a student(s) experience a Catholic education. The recipient(s) of this scholarship must demonstrate need and apply for aid based upon the school's formal financial aid application process. This scholarship of up to \$1,000 will be awarded to a **current** eighth grader, freshman, sophomore, or junior who meets the following criteria and it will be applied to their tuition for the following school year:

- Students(s) must demonstrate need and apply for aid based upon the School's formal financial aid application process.
- Maintain B average or above
- Applicants should be positive role models both in and outside of school; good representatives of AHS values; and be in good academic and disciplinary standing and not have any significant attendance issues.

An essay with at least three paragraphs should be completed. The essay should explain what receiving this scholarship would mean to the applicant and to her family.
