- The scholarship(s) will be given to a `student **entering** either 9th, 10^{th;} 11th or 12th grade at Assumption High School.
- Student(s) must have a cumulative B average or above to apply if current AHS student.
- Student(s) must plan to attend college to pursue a degree in the area of medicine or other STEAM curriculum.
- Students(s) must demonstrate need and apply for aid based upon the School's formal financial aid application process.
- Applicants should be positive role models both in and outside of school; good representatives of AHS values; a and be in good academic and disciplinary standing and not have any significant attendance issues.

Application Process: Applications should be in the form of an essay in which the student explains how she plans to pursue a college education in the area of medicine or other STEAM curriculum. The essay should be two double-spaced pages.
