MARY BYRON PROJECT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This scholarship was established in memory of Mary Byron, a 1991 Assumption graduate and victim of dating violence.

The goals of this scholarship program are to:

- Educate young women about the cycle of domestic violence and help them to identify behaviors that may appear in a dating relationship.
- Help students raise awareness among their peers and show them how to identify and disrupt the cycle of violence.
- Educate young women about the role every profession plays in the battle of domestic violence (i.e. doctors, attorneys, CEO's, teachers, and others...)

This 3-year scholarship is a tuition grant for students who maintain a B+ average. This scholarship will be awarded annually to two current freshmen and may be renewed as long as the student attends Assumption and meets the requirements of the program.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application, along with an essay and two recommendations must be completed and submitted to **jackie.bloyd@ahsrockets.org** by 8:00 p.m., Monday, January 16, 2023. The essay should be three double-spaced pages. It should explain why the student feels she would make a good candidate for this scholarship. It should describe her knowledge and possible experience in a service project or leadership opportunity, how it relates to the field of domestic violence, and how she plans to help educate the community on this topic in the upcoming year.

Please note that this leadership opportunity requires public speaking. New applicants and renewable recipients will be asked to participate in an interview conducted at Assumption High School by the members of the Mary Byron Project Board. Recipients will also be required to make a presentation to students and parents during Mission Week, and they may be asked to participate in press conferences and/or television and radio interviews.
