

## Charles “Chuck” and Marty Horrell Scholarship

Charles “Chuck” and Marty Horrell were firm believers in Catholic education. They sent their six children to Catholic grade schools and high schools, including two daughters to Assumption. The Horrells created this scholarship to help others experience the value of a Catholic education by helping to offset the cost of tuition. The recipient(s) of this scholarship must demonstrate need and apply for aid based upon the school’s formal financial aid application process. This scholarship of up to \$1,000 is awarded to a **current** eighth grader, freshman, sophomore, or junior who meets the following criteria and it will be applied to their tuition for the following school year:

- Students(s) must demonstrate need and apply for aid based upon the School’s formal financial aid application process.
- Maintain B average or above
- Applicants should be positive role models both in and outside of school; good representatives of AHS values; and be in good academic and disciplinary standing and not have any significant attendance issues.

An essay with at least three paragraphs should be completed. The essay should explain what receiving this scholarship would mean to the applicant and to her family.
