

## Spirit of Assumption Award

This award was created by Judy Ribar H'14, a former retreat director and senior class moderator, and her husband John Ribar, to assist a rising senior at Assumption High School who not only demonstrates financial need, but is actively engaged in the retreat program and exhibits school spirit. This award will help offset those expenses associated with senior year or partial tuition. It is important that this student actively participate in class activities and is devoted to spiritual development, such as retreat and mission week.

This fund hopes to award a non-renewable award of up to \$1000 to a **current** Junior who meets the following criteria:

- Student(s) must demonstrate need and apply for aid based upon the School's formal financial aid application process.
- Student(s) must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA or above at the time of application.
- Student(s) must have participated in their Freshman and Sophomore retreat and plan to attend their Junior and Senior Retreat.
- Student(s) should be positive role models both in and outside of school; good representatives of AHS values; and be in good academic and disciplinary standing and not have any significant attendance issues.

Submissions for this scholarship should be in the form of a two page, double-spaced typed essay which refers to the criteria above.
