

LOCATION OF AP EXAMS AND GENERAL STUDENT INFORMATION FOR ADMINISTRATION OF AP EXAMS May 2025

**PACKING LUNCHES IS
HIGHLY RECOMMENDED!**

The **majority** of our AP Exams, which are scheduled May 5– May 16, will be held across Bardstown Road in Highland Hall. This includes extended time testing. Art submissions and AP Research follow a different format for earning AP Credit.

AP Spanish Language: Will be held in the Green Room below the theater, you enter via Arts and Sciences wing behind LSC.

AP Chemistry: Will be held in the Green Room below the theater, you enter via Arts and Sciences wing behind LSC.

AP French Language: Will be held in the Green Room below the theater, you enter via Arts and Sciences wing behind LSC.

EXAM TIMES - For 8:00 a.m. exams you will be required to report to your testing location **NO LATER THAN 7:45 am**. Highland Hall will be open approx. 7:15 each morning, so you may be dropped off at this location for morning exams.

For 12:00 p.m. exams you will be required to report to your testing location **NO LATER THAN 11:45 am**. Students taking afternoon exams may leave from Highland Hall at 3:00pm or **after the exam is finished (if later than 3:00)**.

Lunch – PACKING A LUNCH WILL GIVE YOU MORE TIME TO EAT.

If you have a morning exam and will miss your our normally scheduled lunchtime (regular time exams should finish close to noon, extended time will be a bit later) please make sure to pack a lunch or grab something from FLIK, take 25 minutes to eat, and return to 3rd block as soon as possible.

If you have an afternoon exam, you will not have time to have a FLIK lunch so please pack a lunch, use the Community/RTI time, grab a quick bite from your healthy packed lunch and head to Highland Hall at 11:40, crossing Bardstown Road at the Tyler Lane crosswalk, for your exam which begins with check in no later than 11:45. **PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE.**

If you are taking a morning and afternoon exam, please pack a lunch and drink to eat at Highland Hall between exams.

DO NOT PARK at Highland Hall unless you have paid for a reserved spot AT Highland Hall.

Before exam day:

- Double check where you will be testing. Most are in Highland Hall, several are in the Green Room, enter via Arts and Sciences wing.
- Plan to arrive **well** before your exam's scheduled starting time.

Be sure to bring these:

- **CHARGED** laptop with Bluebook app for all digital exams.
- No. 2 pencils for your multiple-choice answer sheet.
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.
- An **acceptable calculator** if your AP Exam allows the use of a calculator.
- Students with approved accommodations, you must take your exam with accommodations. AP rules do allow you to leave after using at least regular allotted time.

Don't bring these:

- Electronic equipment including phones, smartwatches, fitness trackers, wearable technology, cameras, recording or listening devices, or any other type of electronic or communication device.
- School-owned and school-controlled digital recording devices are allowed only AP Spanish and AP French
- Books, reference guides, notes, compasses, protractors, mechanical pencils, pencils that are not No. 2, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or colored pencils.
- Scratch paper: Students are prohibited from bringing scratch paper to the AP Exam. For AP Chinese and AP Japanese Exams, scratch paper will be provided.
- Watches that beep, make a noise, or have an alarm.
- Computers or calculators that are not approved.
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- Ear plugs.
- Clothing or shoes with subject-related information.
- You may have a have a drink or snack before exams and during break but **no water allowed near testing area or on or around desks.**

A student observed with any of these prohibited items during testing or breaks may be dismissed from the exam, the device may be confiscated, the student's score may be canceled, and no retest may be permitted.

AP EXAM SCHEDULE

- Students must be present no later than **7:45 am for morning exams and 11:45 am for noon exams.**
- Students must arrive to testing 15 minutes prior to start of exam.
- Students bring charged laptops if testing digitally.
- Students pack a lunch if testing time affects regular lunch schedule for that day
- Students may not park at Highland Hall unless they already have a reserve/pd parking at Highland Hall
