College Application Deadline Chart

Requests for transcripts and recommendation letters for college and scholarship applications are processed in order of priority and deadline and should be received by the Guidance and Counseling Center for processing 15 school days before they are due to be received by the college or scholarship agency. This is necessary to expedite the application process and to eliminate the possibility of any error in processing.

To request an official transcript (along with a School Report or recommendation), students must submit the Transcript Request and Application Checklist (TRAC) form to the Guidance and Counseling Department <u>15 or more school days prior to</u> <u>the actual submission deadline</u>. Please note the fee schedule below if TRAC form is received after the given deadline.
