POWERSCHOOL PARENT INSTRUCTIONS

Student information update and sign off on handbook due by 8/13/2025

Returning parents should have PowerSchool accounts. If you have not created a PowerSchool account, please do the following:

- Go to https://ahsvps1.ahsrockets.org/guardian/home.html
- Click Create Account using the blue Create Account button
 - Fill in your information
 - Please put your email address in the Email field and create a username that you will remember in the Desired
 Username field. Please note that you cannot have an @ symbol in your username. While the program allows
 you to enter the @, it is an unrecognized character that will result in you being unable to log in.
 - o Your password must be a minimum of 6 characters. The longer it is, the stronger it is.
- For student name, enter only your daughter's last name.
 - o Your daughter's Access ID is her 7-digit Student Number which begins with her year of graduation followed her unique number. This information has been printed on her class list, her tuition information and mbsdirect.net book order. You may contact the school office if you are unable to locate this (i.e., 2029xxx)
 - o The Access Password is that **same** 7-digit number (i.e., 2029xxx).
- If you have more than one daughter at Assumption, add each of them before you click Enter, and you will be able to access all of them with this one login. Please contact brent.miller@ahsrockets.org if you need assistance with this.

Multiple parent/guardian accounts may be created for each student, allowing access for mother, father, stepparents, etc. Each account should be set-up with a unique email address, using the student ID number in the Access ID and Access Password fields.

ALL PARENTS: After creating your Parent PowerSchool account, follow the steps below to complete the account set up process and access important information for the start of the school year. Be sure to make note of your parent username and password as it will be needed to register your daughter for the 2025-2026 school year.

1. Click the Email Notification icon and select the type and frequency of reporting for email notifications. Multiple emails may be entered to receive notifications and the settings may be saved for multiple students. Be sure to click on Submit to save changes. Once the school year begins, click on Grades and Attendance icon to access your daughter's grades and current schedule



2. This is for School Messenger. This is our new mass communication service. This is where you can set your preferences for both texts and emails. We send emails weekly. If you aren't receiving emails, we ask that you check your information here first before contacting us. For texts, you should have already been sent a text asking you to 'Opt In.' If you haven't gotten that text, it's possible you have already opted in via a previous school. If you aren't sure, you can also check here and make sure you are opted in. If there is still some kind of issue, don't worry as we always send a test message

sometime in October to prepare for weather related school alerts. If there are any issues, we will address them then.
