Accounting / Business / Entrepreneurship / Finance

IN – Indiana University Kelley School of Business – Kelley Women's Leadership Institute

The Kelley Women's Leadership Institute introduces young women to the college experience and business career opportunities.

IN – Saint Mary's College – Business & Marketing Summer Institute

Spark your marketing mind and earn college credit! This week-long residential summer program will help students understand the latest marketing tools and techniques. DC – 2025 ACLU National Advocacy Institute

Gathering in Washington, D.C., high school students (ages 15-18) from across the United States will participate in a week-long learning experience for the next generation of social justice advocates.

DC – The Catholic University of America – World Leadership Congress

Since 1968, the HOBY World Leadership Congress (WLC) has empowered students around the world to broaden their perspective and see themselves as part of something larger—the global community. The WLC is a weeklong program designed to empower rising junior and senior high school students to become more confident, caring leaders, and active global citizens. Each summer, the WLC hosts student ambassadors representing all 50 states and 15+ countries in a major U.S. city. This week-long, immersive leadership experience challenges students to think critically, communicate effectively, and act with integrity. The WLC leaves students with a robust global network and the tools to change the world around them.

KY – Young Leaders Academy – University of Louisville

Kentucky students, rising 11th and 12th graders, are eligible to apply for the Young Leaders The Young Leaders Academy (YLA) is a four-day, all-expenses-paid summer residential program at the University of Louisville for Kentucky students who have completed at least one year of high school by the time of the conference.

Military

CT – United States Coast Guard Academy – Academy Introduction Mission (AIM)

The Academy Introduction Mission (AIM) is a one-week summer program where you'll immerse yourself in Academy life. AIM is exclusively for students entering their senior year of high school and is regarded as the most realistic of the service academy summer orientation programs.

NY – U.S. Military Academy West Point – Summer Leaders Experience

Led by current cadets, Summer Leaders Experience (SLE) is a week-long immersion into the academic, military, and social life of a West Point cadet. At SLE, you will explore West Point from all angles, including our high-tech educational facilities, team-building athletic activities, and realistic military training. Science / Technology / Engineering / Math (STEM)

AL – Auburn University – Engineering Summer Programs

The Samuel Ginn College of Engineering wants to expose students to the world of engineering through our summer programs. The programs will be conducted by faculty, staff and students from the College who will ensure students receive a broad overview of the engineering profession by participating in several hands-on activities.

AL – Samford University – McWhorter School of Pharmacy Camp

Samford's McWhorter School of Pharmacy invites current high school sophomores, juniors and seniors to apply for its Bulldog Pharmacy Camp this summer to learn about careers in pharmacy. Campers will engage in hands-on lab demonstrations, participate in unique service projects, gain essential patient assessment skills and tour local health care facilities and pharmacies.

KY – University of Kentucky Stanley and Karen Pigman College of Engineering – Summer Engineering Exploration Kamp (SEEK)

The University of Kentucky Department of Civil Engineering is hosting three one-week residential Kentucky camps (i.e., kamps!) for rising high school seniors. The Summer Engineering Exploration Kamp (SEEK) will feature hands-on learning opportunities, guest speakers from engineering companies, and field trips to active project sites. Students will stay in dorms on UK's campus along with civil engineering college students who will serve as mentors for the kamps. Throughout the week, kamps will engage in activities to learn the fundamentals of civil engineering by participating in hands-on experiential learning activities. The kamp's emphasis is learning by doing!

KY – University of Louisville Student Physician-Scientist Accelerated Research and Clinical Training Program

SPARC is a six-week summer program designed to introduce high school juniors and seniors to the physician-scientist career path by immersing them in hands-on biomedical research, clinical shadowing, and professional development. Hosted by the University of Louisville (UofL) MD/PhD Program, this initiative provides early exposure to the intersection of medicine and scientific discovery, equipping students with the knowledge, skills, and mentorship to pursue careers as physician-scientists. Students will work on mentored research projects in cutting-edge laboratories at UofL, shadow clinicians and physician-scientists, and attend career development workshops focused on leadership, scientific communication, and the transition to college and professional training. By the end of the program, students will present their research findings at a scientific symposium, gaining valuable experience in scientific communication. This 2025 program will accept only 6 students.

IN – Saint Mary's College – Forensic Science Summer Institute

Do you love true crime and want to experience detective work firsthand? This week-long overnight program is designed for high school girls interested in the fields of forensic science, criminal justice, or science in general. Campers will work together to solve a staged murder by analyzing physical evidence, interviewing suspects, and using deductive reasoning to identify the guilty suspect using all available information.

IN – Saint Mary's College – Healthcare Summer Institute

This week-long overnight program is designed for high school girls interested in a career in the health sciences industry. Campers will get hands-on experience working in the College's state-of-the-art healthcare simulation lab, as well as have the opportunity to tour South Bend's Memorial Hospital and have a chance to learn from the MedFlight Emergency Transport team. Campers will also work with the American Red Cross to become CPR certified.

KY – Youth Community Agriculture Program (YCAP)

Sponsored by the Food Literacy Project at Oxmoor Farm, the Youth Community Agriculture Program, or YCAP for short, is a 7-week summer employment opportunity during which participants will learn more about growing, harvesting, and selling fresh vegetables; learn culinary skills from local chefs at restaurants as well as cooking activities on the farm; and learn more about local food system issues

through activities on the farm and through field trips to community organizations around Louisville. Students work 4 days a week, 30 hours a week.

Spanning from April to November, the Faithways program has three major components: a virtual spring weekend retreat, a week-long summer camp, and optional participation in a fall weekend civil rights trip with Georgetown College faculty, staff, and students.
